2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Not classified as hazardous as supplied

Prolonged skin contact may cause de-fatting and drying of the skin, this may lead to possible irritation and dermatitis.

Eye contact may cause smarting and irritation.

3. COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

The Clu-tac is a homogeneous mixture of mineral filler, inert liquid polymer and process oil.

Clu-tac contains no hazardous components.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation

No first aid should be needed.

Skin contact

No special first aid measures necessary. Wash with warm, soapy water.

Eye Contact

If contact of any material with the eye occurs, irrigate the area affected thoroughly with cold water.

Ingestion

If confined to the mouth, do not swallow and wash out mouth with water. No first aid should be needed.

If swallowed seek medical advice showing the safety data sheet if possible. Do not induce vomiting.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

This product is a low fire hazard and no special fire-fighting measures are necessary

Suitable extinguishing media are – Carbon dioxide, foam, dry powder or fine water spray.

For the protection of fire-fighters a self contained respirator and protective clothing should be worn.

Combustion products may be harmful / toxic and will include oxides of carbon.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal precautions

Protective equipment is not normally necessary. Gloves should be worn if repeated / prolonged skin contact is likely. Avoid contact with eyes. Safety goggles should be worn.

Environmental precautions

Keep away from drains and water courses.

Methods for cleaning up

Scrape up and re-use if possible, otherwise place in a container with a lid and remove for disposal.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

7.1 Handling

General ventilation is recommended. Avoid excessive skin contact. Avoid eye contact and do not swallow. Keep away from food and drink. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water before eating or drinking.

Store in cool, dry conditions below 25°C and away from direct sunlight or heat sources.

During combustion Carbon monoxide and Carbon dioxide will be generated.

Prolonged skin contact may cause de-fatting and drying of the skin leading to possible irritation and dermatitis.
On ingestion may cause irritation of the mouth, throat and digestive system and eventual vomiting.
