2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

The collage kit conforms to all relevant parts of the European Toy Safety regulations (EN71).

Eye contact may cause temporary irritation.

Repeated/prolonged skin contact may cause minor irritation to sensitive individuals.

The plastic chips and the mottled flint may have sharp points or edges.

The coloured sand is not hazardous due to the grain size distribution of the silica sand, the form in which it is supplied and the coloured coating which reduces dusting.

Specific information for Coloured sand

For information the workplace MEL (Maximum Exposure Limit) for respirable crystalline silica dust is 0.3mg/m³ in the United Kingdom, measured as an 8 hour TWA (Time Weighted Average).

10. STABILITY AND REACTIVITY

Chemically stable, no particular incompatibility.

11. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

No specific information is available for the Collage kit. Information on the components indicates extremely low acute toxicity.

Specific information for Coloured sand

Prolonged and/or massive exposure to respirable crystalline silica- containing dust may cause silicosis, a nodular pulmonary fibrosis caused by deposition in the lungs of fine respirable particles of crystalline silica.

Given the grain size of the sand, the form in which it is supplied and the coloured coating which reduces dusting, the product is non-hazardous.

12. ECOLOGICAL INFORMATION

No specific adverse effects known.

13. DISPOSAL CONSIDERATIONS

Can be land-filled in compliance with local regulations.

14. TRANSPORT INFORMATION

No special precautions are required.
