

Washing Recommendations

Disclaimer – Paints do stain. These are washing recommendations and not a guarantee that stains can be removed. It's strongly recommended that all surfaces and clothing are protected.

PAINTS & INKS

Ready Mixed Paint, Powder Paint, Colour Blocks, Tempera Tubs, PlayColor, Poster Paint, Finger Paints, Glitter Paint, Glitter Gel/Glue & Block Printing Ink

Paints do stain

Always protect surfaces & clothing

Wet Stains: Absorb as much of the paint as possible. Wash with plenty of liquid detergent and warm water. Branded makes of washing-up liquid or household soap are particularly effective. When as much of the stain as possible has been removed, wash in normal way. If necessary repeat allowing detergent to rest on fabric. Avoid using strong detergent, bleach and organic solvents. Hand washing can be more effective than machine washing. Do not iron.

Dry Stains: Scrub with nail brush, hand wash in warm (not hot) water with liquid detergent. Repeat as per wet stains. It may be necessary to repeat this process several times.

Acrylic Paints, Fabric, Glass Paints, Marbling Inks, Luminous Paint, Outliner, Peel Off Paint & Drawing Inks

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Wet Stains: Very difficult to remove. Place a pad on the back of the fabric and rub with a cloth dampened with water. Wash with soap and cold water. Repeat wash with soap and warm water. Avoid using strong detergent, bleach and organic solvents. Hand washing can be more effective than machine washing. Do not iron.

Dry Stains: Extremely difficult / cannot be removed. Pick off as much as possible. Soak in warm water and detergent and follow wet stain recommendations. Pad back of stain to help avoid spreading of stain. Dry Cleaning may help.

Adhesives

Blue Label Washable PVA Adhesive, Red Label Washable PVA Medium, Glue Sticks, Papier Mache Paste (Cellulose Adhesive) and Cold Water Starch Adhesive.

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Wet Stains: Remove excess adhesive with damp cloth. Do not rub. Wash with plenty of liquid detergent and cold water and soak overnight. Branded makes of washing-up liquid or household soap are particularly effective. When as much of the stain as possible has been removed, wash in normal way. If necessary repeat allowing detergent to rest on fabric. Avoid using strong detergent, bleach and organic solvents. Hand washing can be more effective than machine washing. Do not iron.

Dry Stains: Pick off as much as possible and then soak in cold water over night. Then follow instructions as per wet stains. Avoid using strong detergents and bleach. Hand washing is more effective than machine washing. Dry cleaning may help.

Black Label Premium PVA Medium & PVA Wood Adhesive

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Wet Stains: Remove excess adhesive with damp cloth. Do not rub. Wash with plenty of liquid detergent and cold water and soak overnight. Branded makes of washing-up liquid or household soap are particularly effective. When as much of the stain as possible has been removed, wash in normal way. Latex Adhesive

Always protect surfaces & clothing

Wet Stains: Very difficult to remove. On textiles, fabrics, carpets, or other absorbent surface etc. it can be difficult to remove and is resistant to normal washing methods once dry. Remove excess adhesive with damp cloth. Do not rub. Wash with plenty of liquid detergent and cold water and soak overnight. Branded makes of washing-up liquid or household soap are particularly effective. When as much of the stain as possible has been removed, wash in normal way. If necessary repeat allowing detergent to rest on fabric. Avoid using strong detergent, bleach and organic solvents. Hand washing can be more effective than machine washing. Do not iron.

Dry Stains: Extremely difficult / cannot be removed. On textiles, fabrics, carpets, or other absorbent surface it can be extremely difficult to remove and is resistant to normal washing methods, however dry cleaning could possibly remove it.
